

# Award overview:

## Fall Prevention Trophy

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### Entrants are required to...

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**Register for and complete one of the following main RoSPA Award entry categories, and the mandatory Fall Prevention question that is incorporated into the question set:**

Entrants must provide a written response and evidence to demonstrate their organisation's approach to the management of falls in the workplace, inclusive of slips, trips and falls, and falls from height.

To be eligible for consideration for the Fall Prevention Trophy, your entry must part of entry-cycle 1, and be submitted ahead of the January 22, 2025, competitive entry deadline. The primary reference period for this trophy will be the 2024 calendar year.

### Category background

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Fall prevention is a current key campaign for RoSPA, as the single largest cause of not just major workplace injuries, but also accidental injury in the home.

The Fall Prevention Trophy seeks to draw on best practice and showcase innovation around fall prevention, both by selecting a high performer as the overall trophy winner, and also sharing advice and learning on the subject with the wider awards community as part of the selection process.

This learning and showcasing of best practice will take the form of a special Webinar – typically in April, at which those organisations shortlisted for the trophy will share their ideas, ahead of an interactive vote, which will input into the selection of the overall trophy winner.

### How the entries are assessed

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- Assessors will first review entrant's responses to the mandatory response theme (found on tab 6b), that addresses the subject of how slips, trips and falls are managed.
- A shortlist of potential trophy winners is then produced and reviewed by RoSPA's judging team.
- Shortlisted entrants will be invited to present their approach to the management of falls at a webinar in April.
- Webinar attendees will then vote for their favourite shortlisted entrant, to aid in the selection of the overall single trophy winner.

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**Please note:** This category overview should only be used as a reference for considering entering a RoSPA Achievement Award. This list is not exhaustive, and registered entrants receive comprehensive guidance within the online entry system.
