Category overview:

Inspiring Women in Safety Award



This award will be made to an individual who has made a significant inspirational impact in the world of health, safety and wellbeing, as either a source of inspiration to their colleagues, or due to their own individual efforts. This may relate to activities within the workplace, or by use of their skills and expertise beyond the workplace.

RoSPA judges will consider how nominees have been a source of inspiration. For example, nominees could be junior employees showing passion in the way they work, a rising star who is influencing networks beyond their organisation, or inspiring senior managers championing gender, diversity and inclusion. All nominees' achievements will be considered in their own right, with seniority and experience not being the most important factor.

Entrants are required to...

- Complete an Achievement, Sector, or Fleet Safety Award submission.
- Answer the Key Performance Questions associated with these categories.
- Complete and submit a separate Inspiration Awards nomination.

How to nominate

- Nominations require a citation of up to 700 words (max), containing a description of why the
 individual has been put forward for consideration, and what makes them a source of
 inspiration.
- In addition, five items of supporting evidence may be submitted to support the nomination.

How the entries are assessed

- All Nominations will undergo an initial screening process, conducted by the RoSPA Awards administration team, to ensure the team or individual represents the Inspiration Award type nominated for.
- All eligible nominations will next be reviewed by an internal team of RoSPA assessors, who will fully consider the merits of nominations received for each Inspiration Award type.
- RoSPA nomination assessors reserve the right cross check the information and evidence presented by contacting either the nominator or nominee for additional details.
- Following this process, a shortlisting will be made of those with trophy-winning potential, before the category's judging panel meet to decide on the overall winner.
